



The Code of Ethics of the Education

The educator, believing in the worth and dignity of each human being, recognizes the supreme importance of the pursuit of truth, devotion to excellence, and the nurture of the democratic principles. Essential to these goals is the protection of freedom to learn and to teach and the guarantee of equal educational opportunity for all.

COMMITMENT TO THE STUDENT

The educator strives to help each student realize his or her potential as a worthy and effective member of society. The educator therefore works to stimulate the spirit of inquiry, the acquisition of knowledge and understanding, and the thoughtful formulation of worthy goals.

In fulfillment of the obligation to the student, the educator--

1. Shall not unreasonably restrain the student from independent action nor lie in the pursuit of learning.
2. Shall not unreasonably deny the student's access to varying points of view including their beliefs and point of view.
3. Shall not deliberately suppress or distort subject matter relevant to the student's progress meaning the real meaning of Christmas, Thanksgiving, Easter, Halloween etc.
6. Shall not on the basis of race, color, creed, sex, national origin, marital status, political or religious beliefs, family, social or cultural background, or sexual orientation, unfairly--
 - a. Exclude any student from participation in any program or celebration
 - b. Deny benefits to any student
 - c. Grant any advantage to any student
